YOUR VOTE COUNTS! Check out these close races:

- * In 1829 Nicholas D. Coleman defeated Adam Beatty by 1 vote for US Congressman (KY-District 2).
- * In Owensboro, KY the 2018 election for State Representative (District 13) was decided by 1 vote. A recount showed that it was actually tied. Jim Glenn was declared the winner when DJ Johnson withdrew his challenge.
- * Kathy Hinkle defeated incumbent Jill York for KY State Representative District 96 by only 5 votes in 2018.
- * In the 2018 Russellville, KY Democrat primary a coin toss was needed to decide the winner in a tied Kentucky magistrate race. Boyce Coles was declared the winner.
- * In Martin County in a 2018 May primary, Margaret Sprague beat Hubert Spence for constable on a coin toss.
- * The vote to allow alcohol sales at Buckhorn Lake State Resort Park in Kentucky ended in a tie. A coin toss was used to determine the wet-dry vote in favor of the park being able to sell alcohol.
